

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Introduction

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his collection of origami projects takes us into the realm of mythology, represented by creatures from both Eastern and Western folklore. You will meet the twelve animals of the Chinese Zodiac, then find yourself in the world of dragons and unicorns.

There are projects for both new and advanced folders, from the simpler diamond, heart, spade, and club to the very complex three-headed dragon. In between you will find a rat, rabbit, horse, monkey, unicorn, and Pegasus to name a few. In the contents the level of difficulty is represented by one, two, three, or four stars.

There are Japanese and Chinese characters for each of the Chinese Zodiac animals. These were skillfully and beautifully drawn by Toshio Mori, the grandfather of my friend Masatsugu Tsutsumi from Japan. There are two kanji characters for each animal. The top one represents the modern character for the animal, the bottom is the ancient character used for the "Year of the (animal)". The Chinese Pinyin pronounciation is given with tonal marks. The Japanese pronounciation is given along with the hiragana (Japanese syllables).

As in all my books, the illustrations conform to the internationally accepted Randlett-Yoshizawa conventions. The colored side of origami paper is represented by the shadings in the diagrams. Origami paper can be found in many hobby shops or purchased by mail from Origami USA, 15 West 77th Street, New York, NY 10024-5192 or from Dover Publications, Inc., 31 East 2nd Street, Mineola, NY 11501. Large sheets are easier to use than small ones.


Playing Cards and Card Suits

The origin of playing cards is largely unknown. The first record of playing cards is from the Orient in the 12th century. Some theorists contend that both cards and chess evolved from a game played with pebbles by shepherds of western Asia. Other theorists believe that playing cards evolve from Egyptian divining rods or arrows that were used for conjuring and divination. Communication with the gods was obtained by casting the rods, marked with four different symbols, upon a central alter; the priests interpreted the commands of the gods according to the direction in which the rod fell. Whatever the origin of playing cards (Oriental, Arabic, or Egyptian), they found their way into European countries in the 12th century, perhaps carried there by traveling merchants, professional soldiers, or wandering tribes of Gypsies.



The diamond symbol is known as a square ("carreau") in French, a bell ("Schelle") in German, and money ("denaro") in Italian.


The card suits evolved through use of different forms and numbers. Early Chinese cards contained suits based on coins. An old Oriental circular pack contained 10 suits of 12 cards each, emblematic of the ten incarnations of the Hindu deity Vishnu. The suits included were represented by figures such as fish, lions, hogs, tortoises, serpents, dwarfs, apes, dragons, shells, men-horse, and wild boars. Early Italian tarot cards contained four emblems (swords, cups, rings, and batons) which were the emblems held in the four hands of the two-headed Indian deity Ardhanari. French cardmakers created the current designs of suit symbols and devised the two-color system for easy identification. Early court cards (Kings, Queens, and Jacks) portrayed various European rulers, but these cards were standardized into their current form by the early 19th century.






The Chinese and Japanese zodiac, much like that of the West, is steeped in a long tradition of mythology and predicting human personality traits, its roots having been traced back to ancient Chinese and Indian origin. The system consists of twelve cylces, each marked by a particular animal.

As one traditional story goes, on New Year's Day, many years ago, Buddha called all the animals of the world to him. Having promised any who came a gift for their devotion, Buddha gave each of the twelve animals who arrived to pay tribute a year which would be named after them. The twelve animals, and hence the twelve years of the zodiac cycle were: the rat, ox, tiger, rabbit, dragon, snake, horse, sheep, monkey, rooster, dog, and boar. Having come to Buddha in this fashion, this is the order that the zodiac cycle follows. In 1900, a new cycle was begun with the year of the rat. Although it ended in 1912 with the year of the boar, one can easily determine their own birth year by counting from 1900.




Upon receipt of a year of their own, each animal imprinted it with its own distinct characteristics. According to belief, people born within each of these years will naturally possess aspects of these characteristics. From knowledge of which sign you were born under, the zodiac can supposedly tell about your personal, romantic, financial, social, and even political traits. The year of birth can even determine weaknesses, temptations, and auspicious marriages for people. Eastern fortunetellers claim that by knowing a person's birth year, they can give advice to adapt and even improve their lives.







People born in the year of the rat are charming, determined, fussy, and frugal. They have a tendency to spend too much money on people whom they love but who do not return their affection. Rat people are quick to anger, but are able to control their temper. They are honest and ambitious and do not give up as easily as the monkey. Rats also like to gossip and are therefore good at making temporary friendships. As rats age, they will make mistakes involving love, but will ultimately end up living well. For long term relationships, those born in the years of the monkey, dragon, and ox are good for the rat while the horse will lead to disaster, even early death.





too big. Rabbits form good marriages with rams and boars but not












Sea Serpent




Sea serpents are essentially western dragons for sailors. Sailors were very superstitious, and if they came across a stretch of water they did not like, would draw sea serpents on their map and write "here be dragons." Sea serpents might actually be rooted in fact, like mermaids (which were thought to be the result of a very imaginative sailor's account of a manatee). Perhaps a sailor saw the tentacle of a giant squid or octopus and thought it was a sea serpent. Legends of sea serpents still exist today such as those of the Loch Ness Monster in Scotland, and Champy, the monster said to live in Lake Champlain in the United States. Modern scientists are still trying to prove the existence of these creatures.














Griffins are mythical animals with the body of a lion and the wings, head, and neck of an eagle. Occasionally, they have the talons of an eagle, or the tail of a snake. Griffins were originally from the early Middle Eastern legends, but found their way into Roman and Christian cultures. Many gargoyles found on medieval churches are griffins, because the creatures represent strength and vigilance. For this reason they are also very common on coats of arms, and the symbol of the city of Perugia, in Italy, is the griffin. They are said to live in nests high up in the mountains, where they guard their ill-gotten hoards of gold from human plunderers.









Pegasus was the Greek mythological winged horse. He was white and had feathered wings, like those of a bird. Pegasus sprang out of the neck of Medusa, the hideous monster who, when seen, turned people into stone, when Perseus cut her head off. From there, he flew to Greece, and the nine muses, minor goddesses who were patrons of the arts, took care of him. Pegasus was a wild horse, and no one but the muses could go near him. Athena, the goddess after whom Athens was named, gave Bellerophon, the great horse tamer, a golden bridle with which to tame Pegasus. Bellerophon managed to slip the bridle onto Pegasus to kill the Chimera, and then, being arrogant and overconfident, used Pegasus to fly up to Olympus, the home of the gods, uninvited. Zeus, the chief Greek god, sent out a fly, which made Pegasus buck, and Bellerophon fell. After that, Pegasus was used by Zeus to carry his thunderbolts, his favorite weapons.







The Chimera was a fire-breathing three headed monster from ancient Greek mythology. It had one head of a lion, the body and another head of a goat, and either a snake tail or another head of a snake. The Chimera was the brother of Cerberus. It lived in Lycia, in Asia Minor and wreaked havoc on the people. Bellerophon, rider of Pegasus, had to kill the Chimera as a penance for killing his brother in a hunting accident. Astride Pegasus, Bellerophon flew over the Chimera and stuck a lance with a lump of lead on the end down the Chimera's throat. When the Chimera breathed fire at Bellerophon, the lead melted into Chimera's stomach and killed it. In literature, the Chimera has been used to represent that which is elusive and just out of reach.



















